Best Hotels Near Masjid Nabawi Madinah

Hotels near Masjid Nabawi can change your whole Madinah stay. And we mean that in a very real, everyday way. When you're waking up for Fajr, heading back for a quick rest, or trying to make your Rawdah slot on time, those extra minutes matter. Madinah is the second holiest city in Islam. It's the city of the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). So most UK Umrah trips include it as standard.

Now, here's the good news. **Hotels in Madinah near Haram** are often **20-40% cheaper** than similar hotels in Makkah. So you can stay close, sleep well, and still keep your budget under control. In this guide, we've listed **20+ hotels near Masjid Nabawi Madinah** with **verified prices in £**, honest pros and cons, and clear walk times. And yes, we'll show you the surprise of the year: a genuine 5-star stay from **£57/night** at Pullman.

Understanding Hotel Areas in Madinah - Which Zone to Stay In

Madinah is easier than Makkah. That's the truth.

The city is mostly flat. So a "5-7 minute walk" is usually a real 5-7 minutes. No steep slopes. No hidden ramps. And no long tunnels like you sometimes get around the Haram in Makkah.

Before we jump into hotel names, let's talk zones. This is where most guides fall short. They list hotels, but they don't explain the **Madinah hotel distance from Haram** in a way you can actually use.

Zone 1 — Central (Adjacent to Masjid Nabawi)

This is the ring right on the courtyard. It's as close as it gets.

Hotels here are ideal if you're travelling with parents, elderly family, or anyone who needs quick access. It's also where you'll find the most reliable **closest hotel to Masjid Nabawi** options.

Examples: Oberoi Madinah, Dar Al Taqwa, InterContinental, Shaza Al Madina.

Zone 2 — Inner Ring (South & West)

This is the best value zone. No question.

You're usually 3-7 minutes away on flat, well-lit paths. And you'll often pay far less than Central. This is where you'll see the Pullman's famous **£57/night** price pop up in quieter weeks.

Examples: Pullman, Hilton, Crowne Plaza, Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick, Millennium Al Aqeeq, Al Haram Hotel.

Zone 3 — King Fahd Road Area

This area has more shops and food spots. It's lively.

Walk times are still fine for most people. And prices can be very fair. If you like being near restaurants after Isha, this can suit you.

Examples: Odst Madinah Hotel, Elaf Taiba, Dallah Taibah, Emaar Royal, Taiba Hotel.

Zone 4 — Quba Area

This is for strict budgets. Or for those who want Quba nearby.

Masjid Quba is the first mosque in Islam. Visiting it is a Sunnah. So some pilgrims like staying close and going often. But for Masjid Nabawi, you'll likely need a shuttle or taxi.

Zone 5 — Airport / Outer

This is only for transit. Keep it simple.

If you land late at Prince Mohammad bin Abdulaziz International Airport, or you've got an early flight, a one-night airport stay can help. But it's not the right choice for a spiritual Madinah routine.

One last point. Unlike Makkah, Madinah doesn't trick you with hills. A hotel that's 5-7 minutes away is usually a calm, comfortable stroll. That's why many UK pilgrims choose Inner Ring and feel totally fine.

Best 5-Star Hotels Near Masjid Nabawi Madinah

Let's talk comfort. Proper comfort.

This section has the highest demand every season. People want **5 star hotels near Masjid Nabawi** that feel calm, clean, and close. And they want real prices in pounds. So we've kept it practical.

Also, quick note. Prices below are per room, per night, in £. They're based on April 2026 checks.

Ramadan can be 2-3x. Yes, really.

1. The Oberoi Madinah

Zone: Central (adjacent to Haram)

Distance: 1 minute walk (directly facing the mosque)

Stars: 5 (ultra-luxury)

Price: £393-£580+ per night

This is the most luxurious hotel in Madinah. It's also one of the closest. Rooms can have wide Masjid Nabawi views. Some show the **Green Dome** clearly.

Service is the big difference here. It's polished. It's quiet. And it feels special. If you're doing a once-in-a-lifetime trip, it can be worth it.

Best for: VIP stays, honeymoon Umrah, travellers who want the very best.

Be aware: It's expensive. And it sells out fast in peak weeks.

2. Dar Al Taqwa Hotel Madinah

Zone: Central (Bab Al Salam side)

Distance: 1-2 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £170-£265 per night (peak: up to £325)

Dar Al Taqwa Madinah is a classic. UK pilgrims ask for it all the time. And we get why. It's reliable. It's close. And it suits families well.

Breakfast is often included. The lobby is busy in peak times. But the location makes up for it. If you want to step out and be at the mosque in minutes, this is a strong pick.

Best for: Families, proximity, travellers who want a proven hotel.

Be aware: Ramadan weeks book out early. Aim for 3-4 months ahead.

3. InterContinental Madinah (Dar Al Iman)

Zone: Central

Distance: 1-3 minutes walk (steps from the courtyard)

Stars: 5

Price: £155-£210 per night

InterContinental Dar Al Iman Madinah is a safe choice. It's an IHG property, so standards are steady. Rooms are usually well kept. Staff are used to UK groups too.

Some rooms have a mosque view. Not all. So if that matters, you must ask for it. Otherwise you may face the city side.

Best for: IHG loyalty members, families, groups who want central access.

4. Pullman Madinah (Pullman Zamzam Madina) — Best Value Pick

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 3-5 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £57-£122 per night

Look, we don't say "best value" lightly. But **Pullman Madinah** really is the standout. In quieter weeks, we've seen it from **£57/night**. That's a genuine 5-star property for less than many 4-star stays.

It's modern. It's clean. It runs well. And the walk is flat and easy. If you want quality without paying premium Central prices, this is the one.

Best for: Budget-conscious travellers who still want 5-star comfort.

Be aware: Mosque view rooms aren't the main selling point here. Value is.

5. Hilton Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 3-5 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £80-£160 per night

Madinah Hilton Hotel is a steady favourite. You know what you're getting. Rooms are comfortable. Dining is solid. And the location works well for most people.

If you collect points, that's a bonus. But even without points, it's a good family-friendly option.

Best for: Hilton Honors members, families, groups.

6. Crowne Plaza Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 5-7 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £72-£120 per night

Crowne Plaza Madinah often surprises people. It's priced like a mid-range hotel in some weeks. But it's still a 5-star brand.

It suits groups well. Rooms are modern enough. And the walk is straightforward.

Best for: Budget 5-star seekers, IHG members.

7. Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 3-5 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £115-£200 per night

Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick (also searched as **Movenpick Madinah**) is one of the most requested hotels in UK packages. It's popular for a reason. The breakfast is well known. Staff are used to large Umrah crowds. And the location is convenient.

Best for: Families, UK package travellers, people who want a "safe bet".

Be aware: It can feel busy. Peak season is intense.

8. Shaza Al Madina

Zone: Central / Inner Ring border

Distance: 3-5 minutes walk

Stars: 5

Price: £70-£130 per night

Shaza Al Madina has a boutique feel. Interiors lean into Arabic-Islamic design. It's calmer than some of the big chain hotels. And it's often priced very fairly for the location.

Some rooms have partial mosque views. Not all. So ask if it matters.

Best for: Couples, travellers who want a quieter vibe.

4-star in Madinah can be perfect.

You get comfort. You get walkable access. And you often avoid the "super busy" feel of some 5-star lobbies. Here are the strongest picks we see UK pilgrims happiest with.

1. Odst Madinah Hotel — Best Value 4-Star

Zone: King Fahd Road area

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £50-£95 per night

Odst Madinah Hotel is a crowd-pleaser. It's modern enough. It's priced well. And it's close for a 4-star. Family rooms and quad options also help with costs.

Best for: First-time pilgrims, best value at 4-star level.

2. Elaf Taiba Madinah

Zone: King Fahd Road area

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £72-£105 per night

Elaf Taiba Madinah is common in UK packages. It's clean. It's reliable. And it's easy to reach the mosque without stress.

Best for: Mid-budget travellers who want a known brand.

3. Dallah Taibah Hotel Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £107-£142 per night

Dallah Taibah Hotel Madinah has a strong reputation. Rooms are often spacious. It works well for families and groups.

Best for: Families, groups, those who want a proven stay.

4. Millennium Al Aqeeq Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 5-7 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £85-£170 per night

Millennium Al Aqeeq Madinah is popular for its location. It's also a good fit for larger rooms. Prices jump in peak weeks. So book early if you want it.

Best for: Proximity at 4-star pricing.

5. Emaar Royal Hotel Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £65-£110 per night

Emaar Royal Hotel Madinah is a familiar name for UK pilgrims. It's often included in mid-range packages. It's not fancy. But it's dependable.

Best for: UK package travellers on a steady budget.

6. Al Haram Hotel Madinah

Zone: Inner Ring

Distance: 3-5 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £76-£112 per night

Al Haram Hotel Madinah is one of the closest 4-star options. That's why it's popular. If you want proximity without 5-star prices, it's worth a look.

Best for: Proximity seekers on a 4-star budget.

7. Taiba Madinah Hotel (Millennium Taiba)

Zone: King Fahd Road area

Distance: 5-10 minutes walk

Stars: 4

Price: £69-£120 per night

Taiba Madinah Hotel is a steady mid-range pick. It's walkable. And it's a good "family safe" choice.

Best for: Families who want mid-range comfort.

Cheap Hotels Near Masjid Nabawi - Best 3-Star & Budget Options

You can spend very little in Madinah. That's real.

These **cheap hotels near Masjid Nabawi** are common in economy packages. They're usually clean and functional. But keep your expectations realistic. You're paying for location and a bed, not luxury.

1. Al Eiman Royal Hotel Madinah

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 3

Price: £47-£72 per night

Al Eiman Royal Hotel Madinah is a solid budget pick. It's close enough. It's used a lot in UK economy stays. And it generally does the job.

Best for: Value seekers who still want walkable access.

2. Al Mukhtara International Hotel Madinah

Distance: 5-8 minutes walk

Stars: 3

Price: £48-£80 per night

Al Mukhtara International Hotel Madinah is another common one. It's basic. But it's reliable enough for short stays. Groups often use it.

Best for: Economy packages and group travel.

Here's the secret about Madinah. You don't need to spend much. The city is flat. And prices are lower than Makkah. Many experienced pilgrims choose a budget stay in Madinah and upgrade Makkah instead.

That said, with **Pullman Madinah** sometimes at **£57/night**, there's almost no reason to go very basic unless you're on the strictest budget.

Hotels with Green Dome View in Madinah - Worth the Premium?

A Green Dome view can feel emotional. It's beautiful.

The **Green Dome** (Qubba Al-Khadra) sits over the area of the Prophet's (PBUH) resting place. A "Masjid Nabawi view" room usually means your window faces the mosque. In some rooms, you'll see the dome clearly.

But you'll pay more. Often 20-50% more per night. So the question is simple. Will you enjoy it enough to justify it?

Our honest view? A mosque-facing room is spiritually uplifting. But you'll spend most of your time inside Masjid Nabawi anyway. So don't stretch your budget for it.

If a view matters to you, tell us early. We'll confirm the room type and direction in writing. Many people book the cheapest room. Then they face a car park. (Yes, really.)

Best Madinah Hotels for Families, Women & Elderly

Pilgrims

This is where the right choice really helps.

We've arranged Umrah trips for thousands of UK pilgrims. And the same issues come up. Lifts. Walk times. Room size. And Rawdah timing.

For families with children

Space matters. So does a fast lift.

- **Dar Al Taqwa** — family-friendly, very close, from **£170/night**.
- **Hilton Madinah** — reliable facilities, from **£80/night**.
- **Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick** — excellent breakfast, from **£115/night**.
- **Pullman Madinah** — modern and great value, from **£57/night**.

One simple tip: quad rooms can be the cheapest per person. They're ideal for families. But they sell out early.

For women pilgrims

Timing is everything. Especially for Rawdah.

Masjid Nabawi has designated women's entrances and prayer areas. Rawdah slots for women can be limited. Times can change too. So being close gives you more flexibility.

- **Dar Al Taqwa** — strong location near Bab Al Salam side.
- **InterContinental** — central access and easy courtyard entry.

Ask your agent which gate is closest to your hotel. It saves stress.

For elderly pilgrims and mobility needs

Go as close as you can. It helps.

- **Oberoi Madinah** — 1 min, flat access, from **£393/night**.
- **Dar Al Taqwa** — 1-2 min, from **£170/night**.

- **InterContinental** — steps from the courtyard, from **£155/night**.
- **Pullman Madinah** — 3-5 min, flat walk, from **£57/night**.

Madinah is flat. That's the big win. Even a 5-7 minute walk can be comfortable for many elderly pilgrims. Masjid Nabawi is also wheelchair accessible, with ramps and designated areas.

Madinah vs Makkah Hotel Prices - How to Plan Your Budget

This comparison saves people money. Every time.

In most seasons, Madinah is cheaper. So many pilgrims spend more in Makkah, then keep Madinah sensible. It's a smart move.

How to Book Your Madinah Hotel - Tips for UK Pilgrims

Booking is easy. But mistakes are common.

We see the same issues each season. Wrong room type. No breakfast. Or a hotel that's "close" on a map but awkward in real life. So here's what works best for UK travellers.

Option 1 — Book as part of an Umrah package (recommended)

This is what most UK pilgrims do. And it's usually the least stressful path.

- Makkah hotel + Madinah hotel + flights + visa + transfers in one price.
- Clear support if anything changes.
- Bulk hotel rates can beat public prices in many weeks.

Option 2 — Book independently

This can work in off-peak weeks. But you'll handle everything yourself.

- You arrange your own Makkah ↔ Madinah transfer.

Booking tips we wish everyone knew

- Book 2-3 months ahead for better room choice.
- Ramadan pricing can be 2-3x. Book early.
- Confirm the exact room type in writing (mosque view, city view, quad, twin).
- Ask if breakfast is included. It varies a lot.
- Madinah stays are often 3-4 nights. Upgrading here is cheaper than you think.

Frequently Asked Questions About Hotels Near Masjid Nabawi

What is the closest hotel to Masjid Nabawi in Madinah?

The Oberoi Madinah (from £393/night) and Dar Al Taqwa Hotel (from £170/night) are among the closest. Both are within about 1-2 minutes on foot. InterContinental Madinah (from £155/night) is also steps from the courtyard. For a closer mid-range option, Al Haram Hotel (from £76/night) can be within 3-5 minutes.

How much do hotels near Masjid Nabawi cost per night?

Budget 3-star stays can start from about £20-£80 per night. Mid-range 4-star stays often sit around £50-£170. Luxury 5-star options can range from £57-£265, with the Oberoi at £393+. The best value we've seen is Pullman Madinah, with rates from £57 in quieter weeks.

Are Madinah hotels cheaper than Makkah hotels?

Yes, in many weeks they're 20-40% cheaper. A 5-star in Madinah can start from £57/night, while Makkah often starts higher for similar proximity. That's why many pilgrims save in Madinah and upgrade Makkah. It's a smart split.

Which hotels have Green Dome or Masjid Nabawi view rooms?

The Oberoi Madinah has panoramic views from many rooms. Dar Al Taqwa, InterContinental, Shaza Al Madina, and Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick also have mosque-facing rooms in some categories. Expect a 20-50% premium over city view. Always request it clearly when booking.

Is it better to book hotels near Masjid Nabawi as part of an Umrah package?

For most UK travellers, yes. Packages bundle flights, hotels in Makkah and Madinah, visa help, and transfers. It also gives you one point of support if anything changes. And it often works out cheaper than booking each part separately.

Which hotels are best for elderly pilgrims in Madinah?

Oberoi Madinah, Dar Al Taqwa, and InterContinental are top picks for closeness. Pullman is also a good option because the walk is flat and short. Madinah's flat terrain makes a big difference. Even a 5-7 minute walk can feel manageable for many.

What is the best area to stay in Madinah for Umrah?

Central is best for the shortest walk and quick gate access. Inner Ring is the best value zone for most people. King Fahd Road is great for shops and good prices. If you want to visit Quba often, the Quba area can work, but you'll need rides.

Do Madinah hotels include breakfast?

Many 4 and 5-star hotels include buffet breakfast, but not always. Budget 3-star hotels often don't include it. Dar Al Taqwa and Anwar Al Madinah Movenpick are known for strong breakfast spreads. Still, confirm it before you pay.

How do I get from Makkah to my Madinah hotel?

Most Umrah packages include intercity transport. Common options are private car or coach (about 4-5 hours), or the Haramain High Speed Train (about 2 hours between Makkah and Madinah). Some people also fly via Jeddah. Your agent can advise based on timings.

How many nights should I stay in Madinah for Umrah?

Most UK trips include 3-4 nights in Madinah. Three nights is enough for multiple prayers in Masjid Nabawi and a Rawdah visit, plus a simple ziyarat. Four nights gives you a calmer pace. If you're travelling with elderly family, a slower pace is often better.
