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## What to Pack for Umrah

**Umrah packing list** stress is real. And to be honest, it's not like packing for a normal holiday. You're packing for worship, long walks, crowds, heat, and the rules of Ihram (the sacred state for Umrah). One missing item can mean an expensive last-minute shop in Makkah. Or worse, discomfort right when you want focus and khushu'.

So we made this page the way our own team packs. It's a full **Umrah checklist** for men and women. It covers Ihram items, shoes, bags, toiletries, medicine, gadgets, money, seasons, and documents. It's also written for UK pilgrims, so you'll see Boots, Superdrug, Primark, Argos, Amazon UK, and Sports Direct.

## Ihram Packing List for Men

Start with the basics.

For men, Ihram is two white unstitched cloths. One wraps the waist (izar). One covers the upper body (rida). It sounds simple. But small extras make a big difference.

We've arranged Umrah trips for thousands of UK pilgrims. Since 2014, the same issues come up. Cloth slips. Pins go missing. Sandals hurt. And someone always forgets a spare set (yes, really).

Now, here's the thing. Many brothers ask, "What to wear under Ihram?" Scholars differ on some details. So don't guess. If you're unsure, read our [Read our complete Ihram rules guide](#) and follow your madhhab or a trusted scholar.

Also, wash your Ihram before you fly. It softens the cloth. It also removes stiffness. Your skin will thank you.

**Quick tip from our team:** buy your best Ihram for Umrah in the UK. You can buy in Makkah, sure. But airport shops are pricey. And you'll be tired. Amazon UK usually has decent sets from about £10-£25.

## Umrah Packing List for Ladies - What Women Should Pack

Keep it light.

Women don't wear the two-cloth white Ihram like men. But women still enter Ihram (the sacred state). So the rules still matter. Scented items matter. Face covering rules matter. And comfort matters a lot.

We've seen it first-hand. A heavy abaya in Makkah heat can ruin your day. And a slippery scarf can become a constant fuss in Tawaf (circling the Kaaba). So pack for ease.

A common question: “Is there a colour for women’s Ihram?” No fixed colour. Many sisters choose white or neutral. It’s personal. But choose what’s modest and comfortable.

If you wear niqab, note this. Most scholars say the face shouldn’t be covered in Ihram. Use a visor-style face shade instead. It helps. It also keeps airflow.

And please don’t ignore socks. The Haram floor can be slick. Non-slip socks are a small win. They prevent falls. We’ve seen slips happen.

## Best Shoes & Footwear for Umrah

Your feet will work hard.

Most pilgrims clock 10,000–20,000 steps a day. Tawaf alone can be a lot. Add Sa'i (walking between Safa and Marwah). Then add hotel walks, lifts, and food runs. It adds up fast.

So your Umrah essentials start with shoes. Also, you'll take them off a lot. That's why slip-on matters.

Break in shoes before you travel. Please do it. New shoes equal blisters. And blisters in Tawaf are miserable.

Also pack a small plastic bag. Use it for your shoes at the Haram. Shoes go missing. Not always stolen. Sometimes moved. Either way, it's chaos.

## Best Bags for Umrah - What to Carry in the Haram

Small is safer.

Crowds in Masjid al-Haram can be intense. A big bag is a headache. It bumps people. It gets caught. It also makes you a target for pickpockets. Theft is rare, but crowds are crowds.

Money belt (hidden)	Passport/cash backup	Worn under clothes

Waist bag is our top pick for Tawaf. It keeps your hands free for dua. It also stops a swinging shoulder strap.

Women often ask about an Umrah bag for ladies. Cross-body wins. It's secure. It's easy. And it stays close.

# Umrah Toiletries - What's Allowed During Ihram

This is where people slip up.

During Ihram, you can't use scented products. That includes perfume, scented soap, shampoo, deodorant, and fragranced lotions. So check labels. "Fresh scent" is still scent. Keep it fragrance-free.

Our honest tip: build a small fragrance-free kit in the UK. Boots and Superdrug make it easy. Simple and baby ranges are often your friend.

And pack Vaseline. Seriously. Ihram rubbing is real. Long walks make it worse.

## Umrah Medicine List - Health Essentials to Pack

Don't rely on "we'll buy it there".

Saudi pharmacies are great. But when you feel unwell, you don't want a hunt. Also, brand names differ. So pack a basic kit from the UK. It's one of the most ignored Umrah essentials.

Paracetamol / Ibuprofen	Headaches, pain, fever	Grab a multi-pack from Boots
Rehydration sachets (Dioralyte)	Heat and dehydration	Pack 10+ sachets
Imodium	Stomach upset	Very common after food changes
Antihistamines (Cetirizine)	Dust and allergies	Makkah can be dusty
Plasters & blister pads (Compeed)	Blisters	You will get blisters
Deep Heat / Voltarol gel	Muscle pain	Legs ache after long days
Throat lozenges	Sore throat	AC + dust can trigger it
Eye drops	Dry eyes	AC dries you out
Prescribed medication	Your personal needs	Bring a GP letter if controlled
Face masks	Crowds	Good for coughs and dust
Electrolyte tablets	Hydration support	Helpful in hot months
Small first aid kit	Small cuts	Plasters + antiseptic wipes
Insect repellent	Mosquitoes (evenings)	Unscented if in Ihram
Anti-chafe cream / Vaseline	Chafing	Men often need it in Ihram

Pack medicine in your hand luggage. Not checked bags. Lost luggage happens. You still need your meds that day.

## Electronics to Pack for Umrah

Your phone becomes your lifeline.

It holds your boarding pass, hotel details, maps, and family messages. It also holds Qur'an and dua apps. So keep it charged. Keep it simple.

**Saudi Arabia plug type:** it's mainly Type G. That's the same as the UK 3-pin. But some older hotels still have Type A or Type C. So bring a universal adapter. It costs about £5-£10 from Argos or Amazon UK.

Download apps before you fly. Wi-Fi near the Haram can be shaky when it's busy.

If you're choosing stays, sockets and room setup vary by hotel. Our [Umrah packages UK](#) usually include hotels close to Masjid al-Haram and Al-Masjid an-Nabawi. It makes life easier.

## Prayer & Spiritual Items for Umrah

This is the heart of it.

Yes, you need bags and shoes. But you also need items that help you stay present. A small dua list can change your whole Umrah. It keeps you calm. It keeps you focused.

Write your dua list before you go. Do it at home. When you first see the Kaaba, emotions hit hard. Minds go blank. A list helps.

## How Much Money to Take for Umrah

Plan it. Then relax.

Money stress ruins focus. So set a simple budget. Most UK pilgrims don't need huge cash. Cards work in most places in Makkah and Madinah. But cash still helps for small buys.

Food (7-10 days)	£100-£200	Near Haram: about £5-£15 per meal
Transport (local taxis)	£20-£50	Uber/Careem are common
Shopping/souvenirs	£50-£200	Dates, gifts, prayer beads

<b>Total recommended</b>	<b>£300-£600 per person</b>	For a 7-14 day trip

**Cash vs card:** take about £100-£150 in SAR for small vendors and tips. Use card for the rest. Also use a money belt in crowds. It's simple. It works.

# What to Pack for Umrah by Season

Weather changes your list.

Makkah is hot most of the year. Madinah can feel cool at night in winter. And air conditioning is strong in both cities. So pack light layers.

Summer	Jun-Sep	38-48°C	35-45°C	Extra water bottle, electrolytes, light umbrella, more sunscreen, cooling towel
Winter	Nov-Feb	20-30°C	12-22°C	Light jacket, warm layer for evenings, warm socks, prayer shawl (women)
Ramadan	Varies	Varies	Varies	Dates for iftar, reusable bottle, energy snacks, patience
Spring/Autumn	Mar-May, Oct	28-38°C	22-35°C	Standard list, light layer for AC

If you're travelling in winter, many people search "what to pack for Umrah in December". Add a light jacket for Madinah nights. Add warm socks too. The marble can feel cold.

Documents first. Always.

Before you buy more clothes, check your passport expiry. Saudi entry rules can be strict. Keep printed copies too. Phones die.

**Common baggage allowance (always re-check your ticket):**

Pakistan International (PIA)	2x 23kg	7kg	Check current policy

Many people also ask about bringing [Zamzam water](#) home. Some airlines allow 5 litres as an extra item. Others charge. So check before you fly back.

## Frequently Asked Questions - Umrah Packing

We get asked these a lot. So here are straight answers.

### What is the most important thing to pack for Umrah?

Comfortable slip-on footwear and unscented toiletries. You'll walk 10,000-20,000 steps on many days. And scented products are not allowed during Ihram. Buy fragrance-free soap, shampoo, and deodorant in the UK before you go.

### Can I use deodorant during Umrah/Ihram?

Yes, but only if it's unscented or fragrance-free during Ihram. Regular scented deodorant is not allowed while you're in Ihram. After you complete Umrah and exit Ihram, you can use normal products again. Crystal deodorant is a common option from Holland & Barrett.

## What shoes are best for Umrah?

Slip-on sandals or slides are best for daily use. You'll remove them often when entering the Haram. For long walking days, pack trainers like Sketchers Go Walk or similar. Break them in before you travel to avoid blisters.

## Do I need a travel adapter for Saudi Arabia?

Saudi Arabia mainly uses Type G plugs, which match the UK 3-pin. But some older hotels use Type A or Type C sockets. So a universal travel adapter is the safest choice. It's cheap and saves stress.

## How much spending money should I take for Umrah?

For a 7-14 day trip, we suggest about £300-£600 per person. That covers food, local transport, shopping, and an emergency buffer. Cards work in most places. Still, carry around £100-£150 in SAR for small vendors and tips.

## What should women pack for Umrah?

Pack 2-3 lightweight abayas, 3-4 breathable hijabs, and comfortable flat slip-on shoes. Add non-slip socks for the marble floors. Also pack unscented toiletries for Ihram. And bring sanitary products from the UK if you have a preferred brand.

## Can I take medicine to Saudi Arabia?

Yes. Keep all personal medicine in your carry-on bag. If you take controlled medicine, bring a GP letter. Standard items like paracetamol, antihistamines, and Imodium are fine. Saudi pharmacies are common too, but it's best to be ready.

## What is the baggage allowance for Umrah flights?

It depends on the airline and ticket type. Saudia often allows 2x 23kg checked bags. British Airways often allows 1x 23kg. Turkish Airlines often allows 2x 23kg. Always check your booking, as rules change.

## What should I pack for Umrah in winter (December/January)?

Pack the standard list, plus a light jacket for Madinah evenings. It can drop to around 10-12°C at night. Bring warm socks too. And add a light layer for strong air conditioning indoors.

## Should I pack a prayer mat for Umrah?

Yes, a small foldable travel prayer mat is useful. You'll use it at the airport, in hotel rooms, and during layovers. Inside the Haram, you won't need it because prayer areas are already set. Keep it light and easy to carry.

## Conclusion

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Packing for Umrah doesn't need to feel heavy. Stick to the basics: comfy slip-on shoes, unscented toiletries for Ihram, a good Ihram set (men), light abayas (women), your medicine, a power bank, and a small dua book. Most other items can be bought in Makkah or Madinah if you forget.

And the most important thing you pack is your intention (niyyah). May Allah accept your Umrah and make it easy.
