Why London is the Best UK City to Depart for Umrah

London is simply easier.

You've got two major airports that matter for Umrah travel: Heathrow (LHR) and Gatwick (LGW).

Heathrow is the big one for Saudi routes. Gatwick helps when you want one-stop deals and more time options.

In our day-to-day booking work, we see it clearly. London has the widest airline mix. That means more seats, more dates, and usually better value for the same week.

- **More direct routes:** Heathrow has the strongest direct links to Saudi Arabia.
- **More airline choice:** Saudia, British Airways, Turkish Airlines, Emirates, Etihad, and Egypt Air are common picks.
- **More departure days:** you'll find daily or near-daily options most months.
- **Good for the South East:** London works well for Kent, Surrey, Sussex, Essex, and the wider South East.

People also ask us about other cities. Manchester is great, but it has fewer direct patterns in some months. Birmingham can be perfect for the Midlands, but the airline choice can be tighter.

London to Jeddah & Madinah Flights - Airlines, Routes & Prices 2026

This is where most plans win or lose.

Your flight choice affects your whole Umrah mood. A smooth arrival helps. A long layover with tired kids doesn't. So below we've set out the main **Umrah flights from London** options we book in 2026, plus what to expect on the day.

Before we get into routes, one quick tip we repeat a lot: if you're travelling in peak weeks, lock flights first. Hotels can be swapped. Flight seats are harder.

Direct flights from London Heathrow to Jeddah

If you want the simplest route, this is it. A **London to Jeddah direct flight** is usually the least stressful.

- **Airlines:** Saudia (SV) and **British Airways London to Jeddah** (BA) are the common direct choices.
- **Flight time:** about 6 hours 30 minutes.
- **Typical return cost:** about £400-£750 in economy, based on season.
- **Heathrow terminals:** Saudia often uses **Terminal 4**. BA often uses **Terminal 5**. Always re-check your booking, as terminals can change.

We're mentioning this clearly because many people search **Heathrow to Jeddah flights** and don't realise the terminal detail matters. It affects how early you should arrive, and where your drop-off is.

And yes, **Saudia flights London to Jeddah** can be daily in busy periods. That helps a lot with date choice.

Direct flights from London Heathrow to Madinah

London to Madinah flights are a beautiful option when they line up.

Saudia sometimes runs seasonal direct flights to Madinah from Heathrow. Flight time is about 6 hours 15 minutes. But it's not always year-round. It tends to show up more in peak Umrah months.

So what do we do most often? Many packages still fly into Jeddah, then do ground transfer to Madinah. It's common. It works well.

If you do find direct **London to Madinah flights** for your dates, we can also build an open-jaw plan. That means fly into Madinah and return from Jeddah. It can save time.

Flights from London Gatwick

Let's be honest. People ask for **Gatwick to Jeddah flights** all the time.

In 2026, Gatwick usually doesn't offer a true direct to Jeddah. Most **Gatwick to Jeddah flights** are one-stop routes. Common connections are Istanbul (Turkish Airlines) or Dubai (Emirates).

- **Pros:** often cheaper than Heathrow direct, and more time options.
- **Cons:** total travel time is longer, often 9-14 hours with layovers.

If you're hunting **cheap flights London to Jeddah**, Gatwick one-stops can be a smart play. Not always. But often.

One-stop routes from London (both airports)

One-stop routes are normal. And for many people, they're the best value.

These are the most common options we book:

- **Turkish Airlines London to Jeddah** via Istanbul (from Heathrow or Gatwick)
- **Emirates** via Dubai (from Heathrow or Gatwick)
- **Etihad** via Abu Dhabi (usually Heathrow)
- **Egypt Air** via Cairo (usually Heathrow)

Total trip time is often 9-14 hours. It depends on your layover length. Short layovers feel great. Long ones can drag.

Still, one-stop routes are often where you find **cheap flights London to Jeddah**. We see it week after week.

Tips for finding cheap flights from London to Jeddah

These tips can save real money.

- **Book 8-12 weeks ahead** for the best spread of fares.
- **Avoid peak weeks** if you can. Ramadan and late school holidays can jump fast.
- **Try Tue or Wed departures.** They're often cheaper.
- **One-stop can be 20-30% less** than direct. Istanbul and Cairo are common.
- **Travel light.** Extra baggage can add £50–£100 per bag.
- **Mix airports.** Fly out from Heathrow and return to Gatwick if it suits.

How much does Umrah cost from London in 2026?

Umrah packages from London start from about £895 per person for a 7-night 3-star option with flights, hotels, visa, and transfers. 4-star options often start from £1,195, and 5-star from £1,795. Your

final price depends on month, hotel distance, airline, and room share. Off-peak months can be far lower than Ramadan weeks.

Which London airports have flights to Jeddah?

Heathrow (LHR) has the most options and offers direct flights with Saudia and British Airways. Gatwick (LGW) usually offers one-stop routes via Istanbul or Dubai. If you want the fastest arrival, Heathrow is often best. If you want more flexible timings, Gatwick can work well.

How long is the flight from London to Jeddah?
