The Saudi Nusuk Visa System: What Birmingham Pilgrims Need to Know (2026)

Since 2023, Saudi Arabia has centralised Umrah travel through the **Nusuk platform** (nusuk.sa) — a digital system for visa processing, Umrah permits, and itinerary management.

For Non-British Passport Holders Living in the UK

If you hold a passport from Pakistan, Bangladesh, India, Somalia, or another country and live in the UK, additional requirements may apply:

- Valid UK residence permit (BRP) or valid UK visa
- Your travel agency processes the Umrah visa through the Saudi embassy
- Processing may take longer (7-14 working days)
- Additional documentation may be required

Prices range from approximately **£579 per person** for short 7-night economy packages during off-peak months to **£4,200+ per person** for 5-star luxury packages during Ramadan. The most popular choice — a **10-night, 4-star package** — typically costs **£949-£1,450 per person** in off-peak season.

Are direct flights available from Birmingham to Jeddah?

Yes. **Saudi Arabian Airlines (Saudia)** operates seasonal direct flights from BHX to Jeddah, primarily during **Ramadan and peak Umrah season**. Year-round one-stop options are available via Turkish Airlines (Istanbul), Emirates (Dubai), Qatar Airways (Doha), and Etihad (Abu Dhabi).

How far in advance should I book Umrah from Birmingham for 2026?

For the best prices and hotel availability, book **4-6 months ahead**. For **Ramadan 2026**, we recommend booking **6-8 months in advance** as both flights and premium hotels sell out quickly.

Do I need a separate Umrah visa, or can I use a tourist eVisa?

UK passport holders can perform Umrah with either a **dedicated Umrah visa** (processed via the Nusuk platform, usually included in your package) or a **Saudi tourist eVisa** (~£120), which also permits Umrah. Verify the latest requirements at nusuk.sa.

Is the meningitis vaccination mandatory for Umrah?

Yes — this is non-negotiable. Saudi Arabia requires all Umrah and Hajj pilgrims to have an **ACWY meningitis vaccination** administered at least **10 days before arrival**. Available at your GP, Boots, Superdrug, or any UK travel vaccination clinic. Cost: approximately £30-£50.

Can families book Umrah packages from Birmingham?

Absolutely. Many agencies offer dedicated **family Umrah packages from Birmingham** with interconnecting rooms, child-friendly hotels near Haram, private transport, and flexible itineraries. While not always mandatory for Saudi entry, **travel insurance is strongly recommended** and should be considered essential. It covers medical emergencies (hospital costs in Saudi Arabia can be very high), trip cancellations, lost luggage, and flight disruptions. Ensure your policy specifically covers Saudi Arabia. Cost: approximately £25-£80 per person.

What should I do if I hold a non-British passport but live in the UK?

You can still book Umrah packages from Birmingham. You'll need your **valid passport, UK residence permit (BRP) or UK visa**, and your agency will process the Umrah visa through the Saudi embassy. Processing may take **7-14 working days** — allow extra time compared to British passport holders.
