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## UK City Departures: London, Birmingham, Manchester & Bradford

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Where you depart from can change the **Umrah package price UK** more than people expect—especially in peak seasons.

### London Umrah packages

London often has the widest flight choice (direct and indirect), and usually better availability.

Good for:

- Families needing flexible dates
- Travellers wanting direct options when available

- Is breakfast included? (If yes, in both cities?)
- What’s the **cancellation and change policy** in writing?

## 3) Common mistakes UK pilgrims make

- Booking based on “3 minutes walk” claims without checking the map properly
  - Not confirming whether the hotel is in the *Haram boundary area* they expect
  - Assuming luggage and seats are included on budget flight fares
  - Leaving passports close to expiry (some airlines/visa processes can be strict)
  - Paying in full before receiving confirmed hotel and flight details
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# How to book Umrah from UK (step-by-step)
