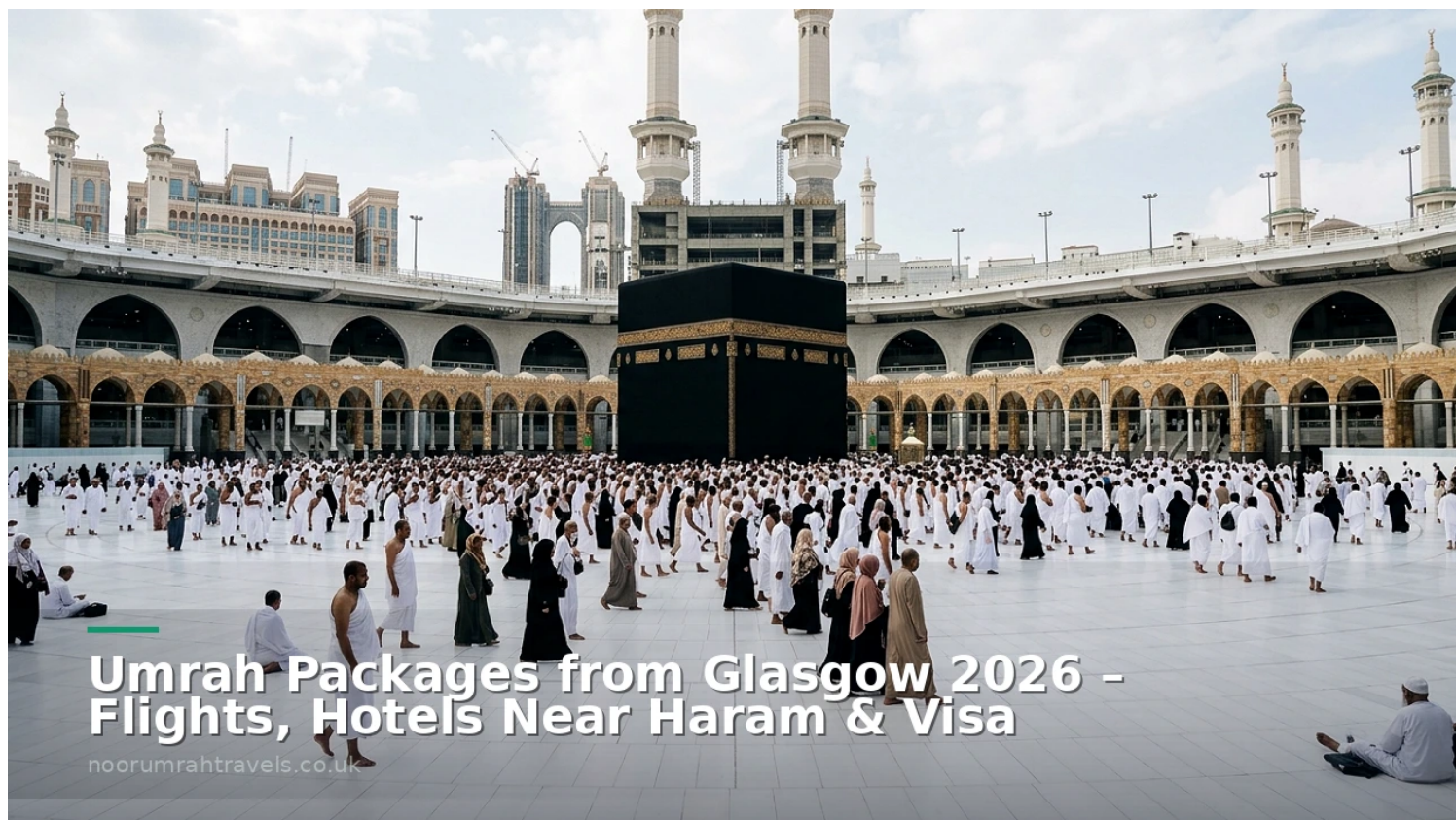

**Umrah packages Glasgow** pilgrims need are a bit different from the usual UK deals you see online.

Glasgow is home to Scotland's biggest Muslim community, and every year we help families, couples and solo travellers make the trip from GLA to Makkah without the usual stress.

But here's the thing. There are no direct flights from Glasgow to Jeddah. So the package matters more. A lot more. You need the flights lined up well, the hotel close enough to the Haram, the visa sorted, and someone to guide you when plans change.

That's what we do. In this guide, we'll show you real 2026 prices, flight routes, hotel options, what's included, what isn't, and how booking works. ## **Why Glasgow pilgrims need a different kind of Umrah package**

It starts with the flights.

Most big Umrah pages are written for London. That's fine if you're near Heathrow. But if you're in Pollokshields, Govanhill, Southside or anywhere across the Central Belt, your trip starts very differently. You need a route that works from Glasgow Airport, not a generic deal with a random connection bolted on.

From our experience, that small detail changes everything. A bad layover can leave older parents exhausted before they even reach Jeddah. A hotel that's listed as "near Haram" can still mean a long uphill walk. And a cheap deal can stop looking cheap once you add flights, transfers and visa fees.

So we plan these trips around real Scottish departures. Honestly, that's why our Glasgow groups tend to travel more smoothly. We look at flight timing, wheelchair needs, room type, train or coach between Makkah and Madinah, and how close your hotel really is. Not brochure close. Real close.

## Umrah packages Glasgow flights - routes, airlines and travel times

No direct flights. Don't worry.

There are currently no direct flights from Glasgow (GLA) to Jeddah (JED). Every route needs one stop. For most pilgrims, that's not a problem. It just means the route has to be chosen well.

Here are the main options we use for Glasgow travellers in the 2026 Umrah season:

For most of our Glasgow groups, we book Turkish Airlines via Istanbul. It's usually the best mix of price, comfort and timing. The layover is often about 2 to 4 hours, which is manageable. Luggage is generous too, and that matters when families are travelling with gifts, extra clothes and Zamzam on the way back.

Emirates is strong if you want a more premium feel. But yes, you'll usually pay more. Qatar Airways is also very good. Smooth airport. Good service. BA via Heathrow can work, though we only like it when the

timing is tight and protected on one booking.

And yes, we also arrange Edinburgh to Jeddah routes. Same idea. Same main carriers. Similar journey times. So if Glasgow dates are tight, or Edinburgh works better for your family, we can plan that too.

One common mistake we see is people trying to piece flights together themselves. It looks cheaper at first. Then one delay breaks the whole plan. Bags don't go through. Airport assistance isn't linked. And suddenly the "saving" is gone. That's why many pilgrims who first looked at DIY options end up asking us to sort the full package instead.

Let's talk real numbers.

We know this is the part most people care about first. And fair enough. You want to know what you'll pay, what you get, and if there are hidden extras. So here's the simple version.

All prices are per person based on shared rooms. Single room upgrades are available. Child discounts usually apply too. Under 12s often get reduced rates, and infants are lower again. We go through all of that before you book.

And yes, these are real prices. Not the usual “from £99” type ads that leave out the flight. We don't like that style. It wastes your time. Our **Umrah packages Glasgow** prices are built around full travel from Scotland, not teaser rates.

## Sample 7-day Umrah trip from Glasgow

Here's what a normal trip looks like.

This is the package many Scottish families choose first. It's short, focused and manageable. Enough time to perform Umrah well, spend time in both holy cities, and come back without taking too much time off work.

<b>Day</b>	<b>What Happens</b>
Day 1	Fly Glasgow → Istanbul → Jeddah. Arrive and transfer to Makkah hotel. Check in and rest.
Day 2	Perform Umrah: Tawaf, Sa'i, then Halq or Taqsir. Rest after.




Day	What Happens
Day 3	Prayers in Masjid al-Haram, local ziyarat, free time.
Day 4	Final prayers in Makkah, then travel to Madinah by train or private coach.
Day 5	Masjid Nabawi, Rawdah slot if booked, ziyarat around Madinah.
Day 6	More prayer time, visit Quba Mosque, Uhud and dates market.
Day 7	Transfer to airport, fly Jeddah → Istanbul → Glasgow.

Tawaf means circling the Kaaba. It's one of the key rites. Sa'i means walking between Safa and Marwah. That's the next main part.


For first-timers, we always say the same thing. Don't rush the worship just because the trip is short. A well-planned 7-day trip can be deeply rewarding if the flights, hotel and local transport are all in place.

## Hotels near Haram and Masjid Nabawi

---

Distance matters. A lot.

After Fajr, after Tawaf, or after a late-night prayer in Ramadan, the last thing you want is a long walk back through crowds. That's why we care so much about hotel location. We don't just look at star rating. We look at the actual route, the lift situation, the road crossing, and how easy it is for older pilgrims.

For Makkah, our 3-star options often include hotels like Elaf Al Mashaer or Dar Al Eiman style properties, usually around 500 to 800 metres away. Clean. Basic. Good for value. Our 4-star choices can include names like Pullman ZamZam, Hilton Suites or Millennium class stays, often around 200 to 500 metres. Then at 5-star level, pilgrims usually want Swissôtel, Fairmont or Conrad style quality, often very close to the Haram.

In Madinah, the same rule applies. A short walk to Masjid Nabawi makes a huge difference, especially for families with children. Good 4-star and 5-star hotels near the women's gates or near the Rawdah access points are often worth the extra cost.

We only use hotels we've checked carefully. And if a hotel says five minutes, we ask: five minutes for who? A young man walking fast? Or a family with an elderly parent and a pushchair? That's the real question.

## **Why Glasgow's Muslim community trusts local planning**

Glasgow is different.

It's home to about 49,000 Muslims, making it the biggest Muslim community in Scotland. Areas like Pollokshields, Govanhill and Southside have long-standing family links with Umrah and Hajj travel. Glasgow Central Mosque has been a key part of that story for decades.

We've found that Scottish pilgrims often get overlooked by big agencies. Most pages are built around London demand. Glasgow is treated like an afterthought. But the flight planning, airport timing and family needs are different here.

Our Glasgow groups often ask very practical things. Can we get a shorter layover? Can we fly with older parents and keep walking low? Can we stay closer in Madinah? Can children share rooms? Can we leave from Edinburgh instead? These are real questions. So we build our planning around them.

And to be honest, that local feel matters. You don't want to explain from scratch that you're travelling from Scotland and need someone who actually gets the route.

## Umrah visa for Glasgow pilgrims

---

The visa part is simple.

We handle it for you as part of the package. In most cases, you just send us your passport details and a digital passport photo. Your UK passport should have at least six months left before travel. That's key.

For 2026, the usual route is an Umrah e-visa or approved Saudi travel entry depending on your passport status and travel plan. Processing is often quick, usually about 24 to 72 hours once everything is correct. We also remind clients about the ACWY meningitis vaccine, which is still an important travel requirement for many pilgrims heading to Saudi Arabia.

One thing we always say: don't leave visa paperwork to the last minute. Even when approvals are fast, errors in names, passport numbers or photo format can cause delays. Our visa team checks those details before submission. That saves a lot of hassle.

## Best time to book Umrah from Glasgow

Book early. Really.

Because Glasgow has no direct Jeddah flight, seats on the best connections can go fast. That's even more true for school holidays and Ramadan. If you want the best mix of price and ease, January, February, September and October are usually the sweet spot.

Season	Price Level	Crowds	Our View
January – February	Low	Low	Best value
March – April (Ramadan)	High	Very high	Book 3–4 months early
May – August	Medium	Medium-high	Hot but often fair value
September – November	Low	Low	Great weather and value
December	Medium-high	Medium	Book early

Our honest advice? Book 6 to 8 weeks ahead at minimum for off-peak travel. For Ramadan, book 3 to 4 months ahead. Waiting too long usually means worse flight times, longer layovers and fewer hotel

choices near the Haram.

## Frequently asked questions

---

### Are there direct flights from Glasgow to Jeddah?

No. There are no direct flights from Glasgow to Jeddah at the moment. All routes need one connection, usually via Istanbul, Dubai or Doha. Total travel time is often between 10 and 15 hours depending on the stop.

### How much do Umrah packages Glasgow travellers usually pay?

Our prices start from £699 per person for a 7-night 3-star package. That includes flights from Glasgow, hotel, visa processing and transfers. 4-star packages start from about £899, and 5-star from about £1,199.

### Which airline is best for Glasgow to Jeddah flights?

For most people, Turkish Airlines via Istanbul is the best value. It usually gives a good balance of price, comfort and luggage allowance. Emirates and Qatar are also very good if you want a slightly more premium option.

### Can I book Umrah packages from Glasgow for Ramadan?

Yes, absolutely. Ramadan is one of the busiest times, so prices are higher and seats go fast. Our Ramadan packages from Glasgow usually start from around £1,499, depending on dates, hotel level and how close you want to stay to Masjid al-Haram.

### Can I fly from Edinburgh instead of Glasgow?

Yes. We arrange Edinburgh departures too. The same main airlines operate there, and journey times are similar. Some families choose Edinburgh if the dates or fares work out better.

## Is the Umrah visa included in your Glasgow packages?

Yes. We include visa processing in our package prices. You just need a valid UK passport, the right photo and the required travel details. We handle the rest.

## How far ahead should I book Umrah from Glasgow?

For quieter months, try to book at least 6 to 8 weeks ahead. For Ramadan, school holidays or larger family groups, 3 to 4 months is much safer. Better flight options tend to go first.

## Do you offer payment plans?

Yes, we do. In many cases, a £100 deposit secures your place. Then the rest is paid before travel. If you need a custom payment schedule, speak to us. We get asked this a lot.

## What is included in your Umrah packages from Glasgow?

Flights, hotel, visa processing, airport transfers and travel between Makkah and Madinah are all included. We also help with guidance before travel and support during the trip. Meals and personal spending are usually separate.

## Can I extend my stay in Makkah or Madinah?

Yes. We can arrange 7, 10, 14, 21 or even 28-day plans depending on flights and hotel space. Some people want more days in Makkah. Others want a longer stay near Masjid Nabawi. We can tailor that for you.
