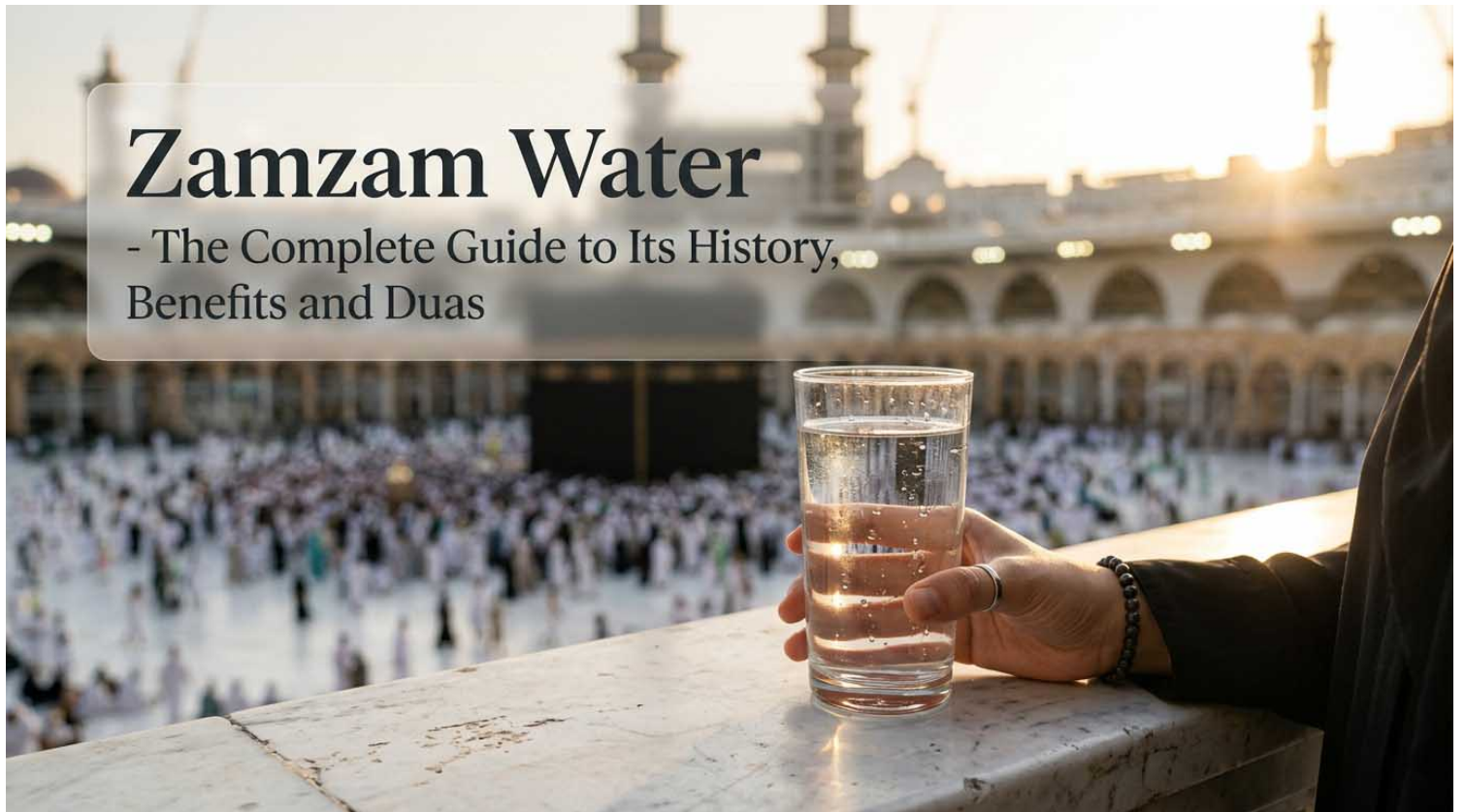

What Is Zamzam Water and Why Is It Sacred?

Zamzam water is the pure, blessed water that springs from the zamzam well, located just 20 metres east of the Kaaba inside Masjid al-Haram, Makkah. It's the oldest and most sacred well in Islam, said to have flowed for over 4,000 years without interruption. Every Umrah and Hajj season, millions of Muslims—including thousands from the UK—drink zamzam water as part of their worship and devotion.

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said, "**The water of Zamzam is for whatever it is drunk for**" ([Ibn Majah 3062](#)). This means you can ask Allah for any need—healing, knowledge, forgiveness—when you drink it. And that's why zamzam water isn't just a ritual; it's a powerful moment of connection with Allah.

The Story of Zamzam - How the Well Began

No story in Islamic history touches the heart quite like the story of zamzam water. It's a tale of faith, struggle, and a mother's desperate hope in the barren desert.

Prophet Ibrahim Leaves His Family in the Desert

Imagine a valley with no water, no trees, not a single soul. Prophet Ibrahim (peace be upon him) is told by Allah to leave his wife Hajar (AS) and their infant son Ismail (AS) here, in what would become Makkah. Hajar, confused and afraid, asks, "Did Allah command you to do this?" Ibrahim nods. Hajar responds, "Then Allah will not abandon us." Her faith is unshakeable, even in the harshest test.

Hajar's Search Between Safa and Marwah

Days pass. Their water runs out. Baby Ismail cries from thirst. Hajar cannot bear it, so she runs to the top of Safa hill, searching for a sign of help. She sees nothing, so she runs to Marwah. Then back again. Seven times she crosses between these two hills, desperate, heart racing. If you've ever performed Sa'i during Umrah, you know this ritual—it's Hajar's story relived, step by step. The Miracle - How Zamzam Water Appeared

As Hajar returns to her son, Angel Jibreel (AS) appears and strikes the ground with his wing. Suddenly, water gushes forth at Ismail's feet. Overjoyed, Hajar tries to contain the spring, calling out, "Zam! Zam!" (meaning "Stop! Stop!" or "Gather, gather!"). She cups the water, and the well of zamzam is born. This spring has never run dry—over 4,000 years and counting ([Bukhari 3364](#)).

What the Prophet Muhammad (SAW) Said About Zamzam Water

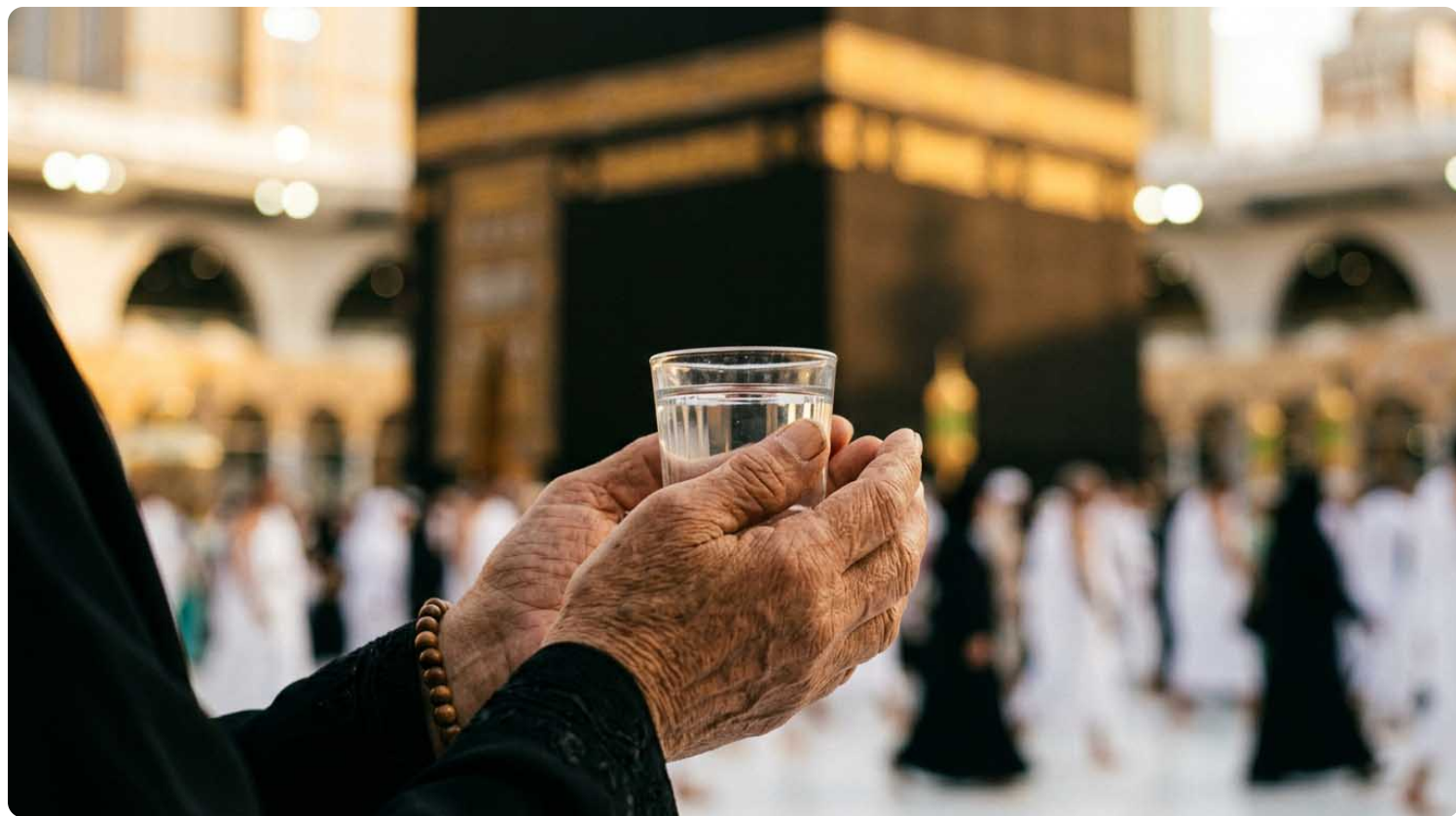
- **"The water of Zamzam is for whatever it is drunk for."** ([Ibn Majah 3062](#)). Make your dua with full hope when you drink it.
- **"The best water on the face of the earth is the water of Zamzam."** (al-Tabarani, classed Sahih by al-Albani).
- The Prophet (SAW) drank zamzam while **standing** ([Bukhari 1637](#)).
- He (SAW) also poured zamzam water over his head for blessing ([Muslim 2473](#)).

The Connection Between Zamzam and Umrah Rituals

Every UK pilgrim who performs Umrah will find zamzam at the heart of their journey. The Sa'i (walking between Safa and Marwah) directly honours Hajar's struggle. After Tawaf (circling the Kaaba), it's Sunnah to pray two rakah at Maqam Ibrahim and then drink zamzam water. These moments are full of meaning and hope. Dua for Drinking Zamzam Water

ARABIC

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّىْ اَسْـَٔلُكَ لِيْ اِيْمَانًا طَيِّبًا وَرِزْقًا طَيِّبًا وَامَلًا مَّتَقَبَّلًا

TRANSLITERATION

Allahumma inni as'aluka ilman naafi'an, wa rizqan tayyiban, wa amalan mutaqabbalan.

TRANSLATION

O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, good and pure provision, and deeds that are accepted.

REFERENCE

How to Drink Zamzam Water According to Sunnah

1. Face the Qiblah (direction of the Kaaba).
2. Say Bismillah before drinking.
3. Drink in three sips, not all at once.
4. Drink while standing (as the Prophet ﷺ did).
5. Recite the dua above or your own heartfelt dua between sips.
6. Say Alhamdulillah when finished.
7. Pour your hopes and needs into this moment—healing, forgiveness, guidance, or anything you desire.

Spiritual Benefits of Zamzam Water in Islam

What Science Says About Zamzam Water

Recent studies (2024-2025) have analysed zamzam water at advanced labs. The results are remarkable:

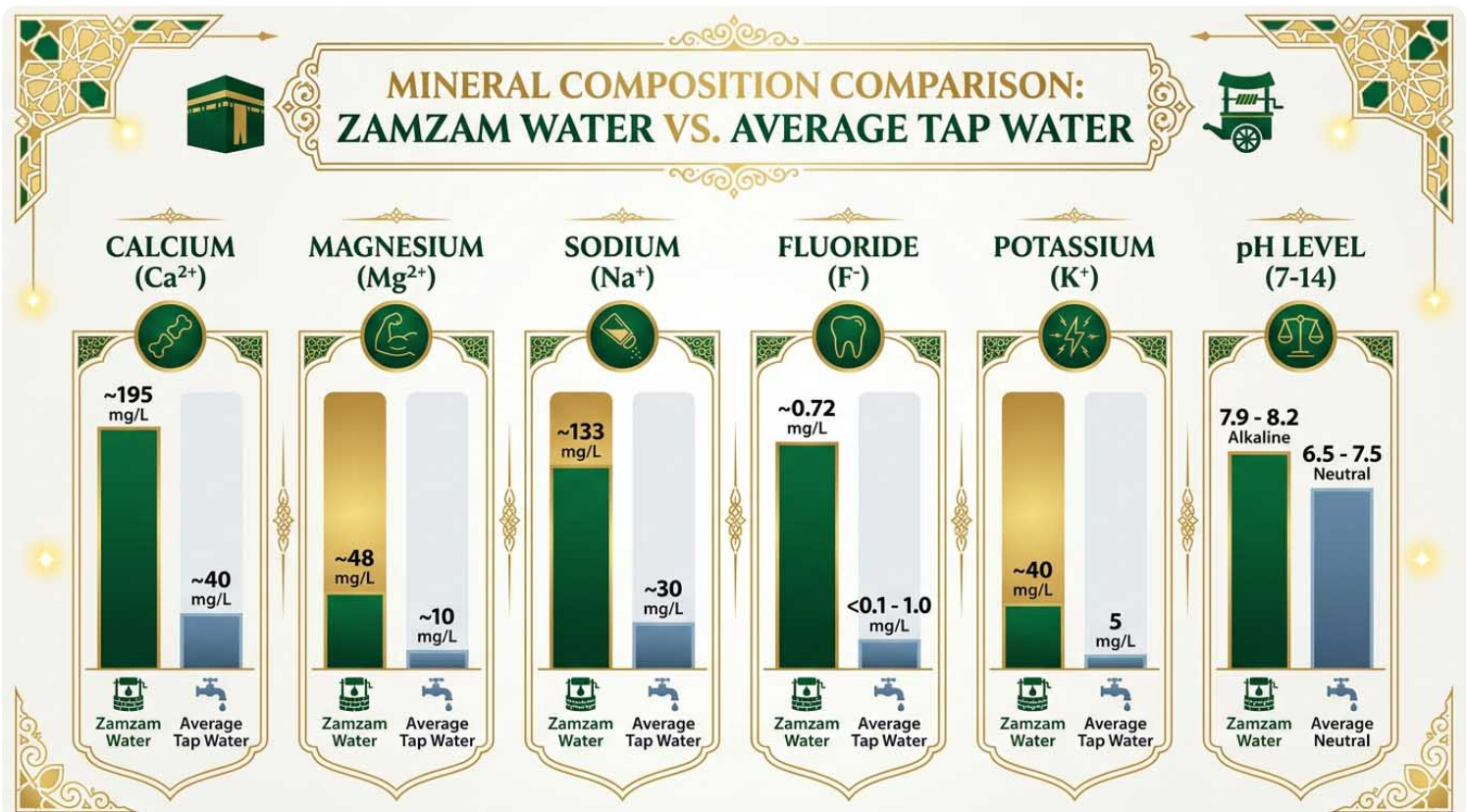
- Higher minerals than most tap water: calcium, magnesium, sodium, potassium.

Zamzam Water Airline Rules for UK Flights

Most airlines flying from Saudi Arabia to the UK allow you to carry one official 5-litre zamzam water bottle per passenger. This bottle **must** go in your checked baggage—never in hand luggage (UK aviation rules limit cabin liquids to 100ml). You'll receive your official sealed zamzam at Jeddah or Madinah Airport after your Umrah or Hajj. Check with your airline before you fly, as rules sometimes change. At Noor Umrah Travels, we brief all our pilgrims on these details before departure.

UK Customs Rules for Zamzam Water

UK customs allows zamzam water for personal use, as it's classified as a food/drink item. There's no duty or restriction for small, personal amounts. Don't bring large commercial quantities—this could be

confiscated. Always keep your zamzam in its **original sealed packaging**. If customs ask, explain it's holy water for personal religious use. For up-to-date details, check the [UK government guide to bringing food/drink into Great Britain](#).

Practical Tips for Transporting Zamzam Water Safely

- Double-bag your zamzam bottle in plastic in your suitcase to prevent leaks.
- Wrap clothing around it for extra protection.
- Place it in the centre of your suitcase, away from the sides.
- Some UK pilgrims bring empty bottles from home and fill them at Masjid al-Haram—this is allowed.
- Keep the original receipt or packaging for customs if needed.

Fake Zamzam Water in the UK - How to Stay Safe

Sadly, fake zamzam water is a real problem in the UK. We've seen it in London shops and even online. Here's what you need to know.

Why Fake Zamzam Water Is a Problem in the UK

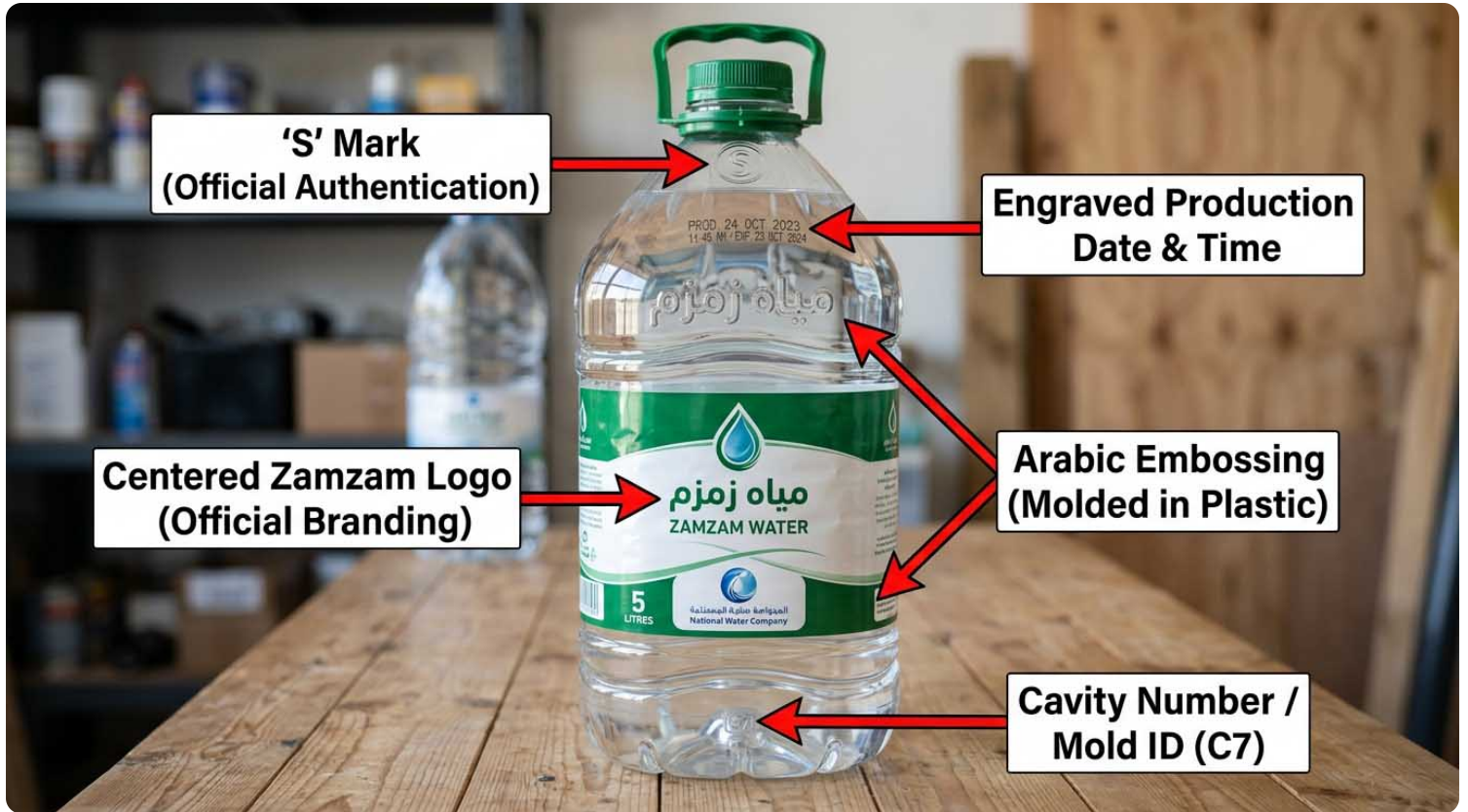
Saudi Arabia bans all commercial export of zamzam water. Any zamzam sold in UK shops, online, or on social media is almost definitely not genuine. Lab tests (including in Ealing, London) have found some "zamzam" bottles contain dangerous substances like high arsenic. This is both a health risk and a religious concern.

How to Identify Authentic Zamzam Water

Real zamzam water comes from someone who physically brought it from Saudi Arabia, usually in an official 5-litre bottle given at the airport. Genuine zamzam bottles have:

- An embossed "S" mark on the bottom.
- A centred zamzam logo.
- "Zamzam" embossed in Arabic (not just a sticker).
- An engraved production date (not ink printed).
- A cavity number (from 1 to 15) at the base.

If any of these are missing, be cautious. Never buy zamzam water from UK shops, online sellers, or social media. It's simply not worth the risk—to your health or your worship.

Zamzam Water During Your Umrah Journey - When and Where to Drink It

Your first sip of zamzam water in Masjid al-Haram is unforgettable. Most pilgrims drink it:

- After Tawaf and praying two rakah at Maqam Ibrahim (the Sunnah moment).
- From dispensers placed throughout Masjid al-Haram and Masjid an-Nabawi (Madinah).
- At any time during your stay—not just after Tawaf.
- Many UK pilgrims fill extra bottles to share with family back home.

1. Forgetting to make dua before drinking. Zamzam is for whatever it is drunk for—don't miss the chance.
2. Not knowing the airline rules and losing your zamzam at security.
3. Putting zamzam in hand luggage instead of checked baggage.
4. Buying "zamzam" in UK shops or online—it's likely fake.
5. Packing the bottle badly—resulting in leaks.
6. Drinking while sitting (the Sunnah is to stand).
7. Carrying too much and running into customs trouble.

FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions About Zamzam Water

Is zamzam water safe for babies and children?

Yes. Zamzam water is safe for babies and children. Scientific studies confirm it is free from bacterial contamination and meets WHO drinking water standards. Many Muslim parents give small amounts of zamzam water to newborns as a first drink, following the tradition of tahneek. Always ensure the zamzam is authentic and from a trusted source.

Does zamzam water expire or go off?

Zamzam water does not have a formal expiry date. When stored properly in sealed, clean containers away from direct sunlight and heat, it can remain safe to drink for years. However, once opened, treat it like any water and consume within a reasonable time. If the taste, colour, or smell changes, do not drink it.

Can you use zamzam water for cooking or wudu?

Yes. There is no Islamic prohibition on using zamzam water for cooking, wudu, or any other purpose. However, most Muslims prefer to drink it with intention and dua due to its sacred status. Using it for wudu is permissible and even considered blessed by some scholars.

Is it permissible to sell zamzam water in Islam?

Scholars have different views. The majority of scholars say zamzam water should not be sold commercially and is a gift from Allah meant to be shared freely. Saudi Arabia bans commercial export. Selling it in the UK is not officially sanctioned and most zamzam available for purchase outside Saudi Arabia is likely not authentic.

Can non-Muslims drink zamzam water?

Yes. There is no Islamic ruling preventing non-Muslims from drinking zamzam water. It is water from a blessed source and many non-Muslims have tasted it out of curiosity or when offered by Muslim friends. There is no sin or issue in sharing zamzam with people of other faiths.

How deep is the zamzam well and has it ever dried up?

The zamzam well is approximately 30 metres deep. It has never completely dried up in over 4,000 years, which Muslims regard as a miracle. During pumping tests, researchers found the well produces 11 to 18.5 litres per second. When pumped heavily, the water level drops but recovers completely within minutes.

Can you visit the zamzam well directly?

The zamzam well itself is no longer directly accessible to the public. It is located in the basement of Masjid al-Haram, sealed for preservation and safety. However, zamzam water is freely available from coolers and dispensers throughout the mosque. You can drink as much as you wish during your visit.

Is zamzam water available in Madinah or only Makkah?

Yes, zamzam water is available in Madinah. The Saudi government transports zamzam water from Makkah to Masjid an-Nabawi in Madinah, where it is distributed through coolers and dispensers. UK pilgrims visiting Madinah as part of their Umrah trip can drink zamzam there as well.
